



Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)

Persistent organic pollutants (POPs) are organic substances that persist in the environment, accumulate through the food chain and pose a risk to human health and the environment.

The Stockholm Convention Persistent Organic Pollutants Review Committee (POPRC) reviews and updates the Stockholm Convention's list of persistent organic pollutants (POPs) which details the substances that are eliminated, restricted or subject to limitations. HMS monitors this list in conjunction with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 on persistent organic pollutants.

To the present and best of our knowledge, and based upon the information available to us, HMS's products are in compliance with the POPs Regulation and don't contain substances subject to prohibitions listed in Annex I to Regulation (EU) 2019/1021. We continue to follow up the update of the POPs regulation and ensure the conformity of our products.
